

FRIDA FJELLMAN

b. 1971, Sweden

Frida Fjellman is a Stockholm-based multi-disciplinary artist. Originally trained as a ceramist, Fjellman has since expanded her practice to include works in glass, wood, and neon, all executed with the same mastery of medium. At the core of her practice is a divergence from the subtle minimalism that characterizes most traditional and contemporary Swedish art and design. The artist experiments with her own perception of the Swedish aesthetic, appropriating and subverting the traditional elements of Swedish design and typified beauty to create highly personal sculptures and installations, which in many ways evoke the Northern Swedish landscape.

Fjellman's tableaux often involve lifelike animal figures frozen in richly detailed ceramic or manifestations of light and weather rendered in glass and neon; the overall effect is that of a dreamlike state. Her fantastical, gem-like, suspended installations rendered in glass link together colored crystals, while LED light transmits and reflects from one prism to the next, creating a hypnotic spectacle of color and light. These playful works, rich in color and decorative flourish, fashion a modern baroque approach, marrying lush beauty with exacting detail and technical skill. As in much of Fjellman's work, she plays here upon the wonderment of suspended art, which is often the essence and manifestation of her creativity—an opportunity to create spectacle.

Fjellman's diverse and provocative projects, executed with impressive versatility across multiple media, have made her a standout contemporary artist both in Sweden and internationally. She is a graduate of Konstfack University College of Arts, Crafts, and Design, where she received her MFA from the Department of Ceramics and Glass. Additional studies include time at the studio of the Corning Museum of Glass in Corning, NY, and the Pilchuk School of Glass in Stanwood, WA. Fjellman is the recipient of numerous scholarships and awards, including the Stockholm City Cultural Award, the Erik Höglund Scholarship, and others. Her work has been placed in prestigious public and private collections worldwide, including the Nationalmuseum in Stockholm, Ebeltoft Glass Museum in Denmark, Röhsska Museum in Gothenburg, and the American Museum of Glass in New Jersey.
