

HOSTLER BURROWS

KARI DYRDAL

b. 1952, Norway

Kari Dyrdal is a textile artist, known for her monumental tapestries that exhibit a dual mastery of a cultural tradition of hand weaving along with intricately researched digital production. Dyrdal's process involves a deep investigation on memory, incorporating pattern, repetition and structure as expressions of her ideas on aesthetics and cultural heritage. Her digital weaving process allows for textiles to reach large, architectural scales. An affinity for digital aesthetics, such as tightly packed pixels and fine-tuned mechanized control of weaving, allows for a new intimacy to emerge for a creator who works at the crossroads between craft and technology. Working from her own personal photography, Dyrdal considers the use of recognizable images as essential to her technique, helping to expand the potential of what can be communicated through woven structures. Dyrdal transforms her photography within the digital loom to create a juxtaposition between pictorial representation and abstraction. Her photographs serve not just as data for the computer to weave a tapestry, but as evidence of a moment in time, whose feelings can be brought to life through technology.

Dyrdal serves as a professor in the Faculty of Art, Music, and Design at the University of Bergen. She received a degree in textile art from Bergens Kunsthåndverksskole in 1977 and did postgraduate study at the Croydon College of Art and Technology in London in 1978. Her work has been exhibited at the National Museum, Oslo, the KODE/Vestlandske Kunstindustrimuseum, Bergen, and the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston.
